

## ARAPAHOE REFERRAL SOURCE






## WHAT DOES THE RED TEAM DECIDE?

- Does the report of alleged child maltreatment meet the statutory threshold?
- If so, what is the appropriate response time? (Immediate, 3 Day, 5 Day)
- Does the accepted report require a forensic or High Risk Assessment Response (HRA) or an alternative, Family Assessment Response (FAR)?
- If it does not meet the threshold of child protection intervention, should it be referred for Community Development or Prevention Services?

13,348 child protection referrals

**5174** child protection referrals were investigated (39%)

**314** of those investigated were transferred to permanency services (6%)

3071 adult protection referrals generated resulting in 565 investigations and
